

DATES: June 4-9

DISCIPLINES: Each week will have instructors in both English and Western riding. Beginning, intermediate and advanced classes will be offered. Trail and speed events will also be covered.

LOCATION: Welaka State Forest — just south of Palatka, Florida.

EXPENSES: \$270 — includes all meals, snacks, t-shirts, lodging, stabling, and over 30 hours of instruction for the week. You will need to provide your own feed and hay. Bedding for the horses is provided.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: Youth between the ages of 11 and 18 (as of September 1, 2005) are able to participate.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Bunk-house camping. You will need your own linens, but the cabins are air conditioned so you can cool off after a hard day in the saddle.
